We live in a world at war, and that is not a metaphor. For the second year in a row, Philadelphia is about to set a new record for murders. Ditto, Memphis, Chicago and Portland, OR. Under the guise of social justice, this war visits violence and death on the very citizens it purports to help. In an advanced, civilized, Christian nation... we're at war in the very land we call home.

Globally, Islam hates Christianity and has declared war on Christians everywhere. It does no good to defend millions of Islamic adherents who are not warmongers. 9/11 and 21 years of terror leave an undeniable legacy of savagery and hatred. Additionally, atheists in Russia and China despise everything Christians stand for and aggressively target them.
