## BARNER FAMILY - MISSIONARIES TO THE PHILIPPINES

Rev. Paul Barner, D. Min. Ed, was born in 1961 right here in Albany, NY. In 1996 he and Elvie were married and blessed with two children, Timothy born in 1997 and Abigail in 2000. Paul is an Ironman triathlete having competed in four triathlons. He has received too many honors to list here.

They have been missionaries in the Philippines since July 6, 1996.

Paul has served as Teacher/Professor at the Davao Alliance Bible College, Barner Learning Center, Davao Music Theological Seminary, Alliance Theological Education by Extension, the Rolla Public Schools, Lifestream Academy, St James Public Schools, Sullivan Public Schools, Cuba Public Schools, and East Greenbush Central Schools.

They founded Faith Alliance Fellowship in February 1997 and have served as pastors for the last 19 years. They founded Father's House Foundation for Street kinds and Other Children At Risk in 2006. Paul has served as Director of the Child Evangelism Fellowship, District 2 Buhangin Davao City, Philippines for 8 years and has served on the Board of Trustees of Davao Christian Leadership Foundation, Inc. (DCL) since 2010.

Paul's ministry is mostly in communication, planning, organization, prayer and training. Elvie does most of the hands-on work of administration and interaction. Evangelism and youth work is done by the nationals whom they have trained, since they do it best.

Their main responsibility while in the USA is to find more sponsors (at \$25/month) for destitute illiterate Filipino children to be able to attend Christian school.
