We struggle to understand why God doesn't answer our prayers. If we put it in contemporary speak, we would ask why God can't get on our page. And that is not to trivialize the issue. There are enough places in the Bible that encourage us to trust God, to believe He will answer our prayers, that it becomes cognitive disconnect when it doesn't happen. That's a fancy way of saying it challenges our faith.

And there are no satisfying answers. Don't misunderstand. There are answers. They just don't satisfy us. And that becomes the issue.

It's mentally taxing trying to fit our little lives into the larger scheme of God's plans. And if we believe in God, then we know - we know - He has to be a planner. Why can't He just share it with us so we could understand? Until we go a step deeper and realize that there's a possibility – okay, a small possibility – that God's infinite plan might not compute in our finite human minds. Cognitively we get that. Personally, emotionally, not so much.


And that's where faith starts. Not a pleasant reality. And that's saying it kindly. By definition, faith begins where our mental comprehension ends. But mental comprehension is not as big a barrier as personal identity and emotion reactions. When in our souls we don't "get it," that's different than when in our minds we don't get it.

Trust is such a small word. But it's all through the Bible. And some of the greatest personalities in those pages built their entire lives on that word. And not because they wanted to or because they comprehended, even at the deep soul level.

Think about that. And know that they didn't understand any more than we do. Psalm 33:4: For the Word of the Lord is right; and all His work is done in faithfulness.
