When Jesus prayed
from the cross,
***“Father, forgive them,
they don’t know what***

they are doing,” how could He possibly be telling the truth? The Jewish Sanhedrin was so determined to ***“deal with”*** Jesus that they pressured Pilate to hear the case. And they did nothing to ensure their places in the Roman system by presenting false witnesses to lie about the young Rabbi. Pilate’s personal investigation led him to find no fault in Jesus, and he told the Jewish rulers that.

But they were not mollified. Even after Pilate offered them a convicted criminal, they continued their sham. ***“He claims to be our King, and we have no king but Caesar!”*** A few hours later, the ridiculous court sham completed, Pilate said to his soldiers, ***“Okay, crucify Him, and place this above His head: ‘Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews.’”*** They Jews argued over the superscription, but Pilate replied, ***“What I have written, I have written.”***

The Jewish leaders knew who Jesus was, but they were more determined to kill Him than to accept Him. What they did not know was why He had come in the first place, and that was the point of Jesus’ remark from the cross. ***“They don’t know what they are doing”*** was Jesus’ way of reminding His Father that He came to earth to save sinners, not condemn them. After His resurrection, every Jewish leader had another chance to see Jesus glorified. Nicodemus and Saul changed the course of their lives. We have that same opportunity. Those who choose Jesus will live in His resurrection! 1 Peter 1:3-5:

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to His great mercy, He has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you, who by God’s power are being guarded through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

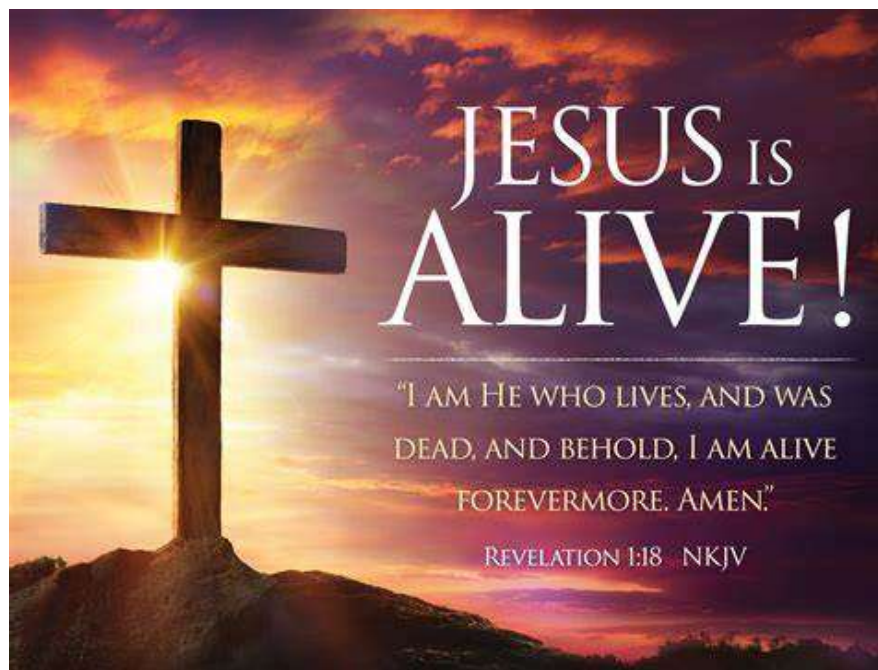
