One year ago, today our nation held its breath as presidential candidate Donald J. Trump went down bleeding from an assassin's bullet. Moments later he rose in the arms of two secret service individuals, fist in the air, blood streaking across his face as he yelled, "Fight! Fight! Fight!"

It was the most astounding sight any American had ever seen. In our lifetime President John F. Kennedy was shot and killed. Our focus has been threefold; to Evangelize the lost, to Encourage leaders and to Equip the Church. We continually evangelize on the streets of Berlin, Romanian villages and this year Africa and Poland. We have seen salvations, signs, wonders and watched God provide "manna from the sky" to reach lost people with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. As we travel, there is one common heartbreak we come across in each region visited, hurting pastors/leaders. Our focus has been to be the sounding board they need, to build relationships of trust through prayer, mentorship, training and to serve alongside these brave heroes of the faith.
