Jesus messed with people's lives.

When you think about it, it doesn't sound like that's what He was doing. He was an itinerant Jewish Rabbi that the people called a prophet because He wandered His way around Israel speaking to crowds. Because of their traditions and their hopes for freedom and respect, all the people saw Him as the Messiah, gaining popularity because of His incredible miracles.

But He was changing lives whether they knew it or not. Some of them – like the Twelve – He called away from their businesses and families to tour with Him. They became even more convinced He was the political Messiah, come to restore Israel's greatness and freedom. Was He spiritual? Yes, and He never let them forget it. But they lived in the political mess of the Roman Empire and that's what they saw as the biggest problem with life in Israel.

What do we think about in our lives? Progressives, liberals, Democrats, conservatives, Republicans, activists (of any kind), inflation, interest rates. It's all politics, sociology and money, and it's a mess. Jesus talks to us about what to think and how to believe in God, but our "real" lives never leave our minds. We have the same problem the first believers had: how to get our heads out of the day-to-day. Jesus came to change the world. Has it worked? 2,000 years later one out of every three humans is a Christian, so you tell me. Ephesians 4:20-24:
